

Ice Cream in a Bag

PARTNER DIRECTIONS
METRIC RECIPE

Person #1 Measure the following into the quart ziploc bag:
→ 250 ml whole milk
→ 30 ml sugar
→ 5 ml vanilla extract
Squeeze out all the air and *seal the bag tightly*.

Person #2 Measure 1 liter of ice and pour it into the gallon ziploc bag.

Measure 60 ml salt and pour over the ice.

Together Place the small bag inside of the large one.
Seal the large bag tightly.

Together Power up your “ice cream machine” by *gently* passing the bag back and forth, tossing and flipping it for 5 - 10 minutes.

Person #1 When the ice cream seems ready, wash your hand and get 1 cup, 1 spoon, and 1 paper towel for each of you.

Person #2 Wash your hands. Divide it evenly between the two of you.
Add toppings if desired.
